Despite it being considered the primary cause of lone rider accidents (an accident where no other vehicles are involved) not a lot is taught or talked about when it comes to target fixation. So what is it and how do you avoid it. I believe the term was coined by motorcycle handling guru and founder of the California Superbike school Keith Code. It was one of his dozen odd survival reactions. So called because it was considered an instinctive reaction dating back to the days when we all lived in caves. Back then when you went outside a lot of things could kill you. When you spotted a sabre tooth tiger your best chance of survival was to freeze while focusing intently on those teeth then back away without taking your eyes off the tiger.

Now if you are on your bike coming in to a corner and there straight in front of you is a big tree or a concrete wall or a ditch then fixating on one of these could be bad for your health. The reason is that without realising it you will steer to where you are looking. Straight in to the danger instead of around the corner. Target fixation is most usually the result of lack of seat time. Not just because you are a beginner but you may be out of practice if your bike has been in the shed over winter.

So how to avoid target fixation? Well it is pretty simple. As you approach a corner a quick look to check where your line is going to be and as you tip in look at the apex and the exit. Vanishing point is another concept that seems to have fallen out of favor however it is the point at which you can see through the apex and exit down the road ahead. It is also the point at which you can roll on the throttle. This will pick up the bike as well as transferring weight to the rear to increase rear traction.

By the time you have done the whole cornering process a few thousand times then looking through the corner will become so ingrained that there is little risk of target fixation. Practice, relaxing, staying calm and enjoying the ride is the key to overcoming a survival reaction so get out there and ride!



## **Important Runs Information**

For all rides, please be at the departure point 10 Minutes early with a FULL GAS TANK and an EMPTY BLADDER. If you are not sure if the run may be cancelled because of inclement weather phone the RIC before leaving home.

#### **Ride format**

SHORT: 150 km, MEDIUM: 150 - 300 km, LONG: 300 - 500 km, XTRA/LONG: Over 500 km.

CRUISE: These runs, usually monthly on a Saturday are offered at a more leisurely pace and of short distance.

ANYONE: A ride for any Club member, noting that you are to assess your own capability in relation to the RIC of the day, the destination and likely distance. EXPERIENCED: Intended for experienced riders these are generally longer rides with less stops to regroup.

Each RIC will carry a Mobile Phone for emergencies. You will be required to provide your own details and contact details on arrival and before the ride briefing.
