Big News for Kiwi Riders: AMX Coming to New Zealand

New Zealand's motorcycle accessories market is about to get a major new player.

Australian motorcycle retailer **AMX (All Motorcycle X-cessories)** has announced plans to open three stores in New Zealand before Christmas 2026, with locations planned for **Auckland, Wellington, and Christchurch**.

For those who have ridden across the Tasman, AMX is well known as Australia's largest specialist motorcycle accessories retailer, operating more than 47 stores nationwide and offering everything from riding gear and helmets to parts, tyres, luggage, and accessories.

The move follows AMX's acquisition of New Zealand distributor **Darbi Accessories**, giving the company an established foothold in the local motorcycle industry.

Interestingly, AMX is part of the **GPC Asia Pacific** group, the same parent company behind familiar brands such as **Repco** and **NAPA Auto Parts**.

Whether this means more choice, sharper pricing, or better availability of riding gear remains to be seen, but it is certainly welcome news for New Zealand motorcyclists. The stores are expected to operate seven days a week, supported by online shopping for riders throughout the country.

It's always encouraging to see investment in motorcycling, and we'll watch with interest to see how AMX's arrival shapes the local market.

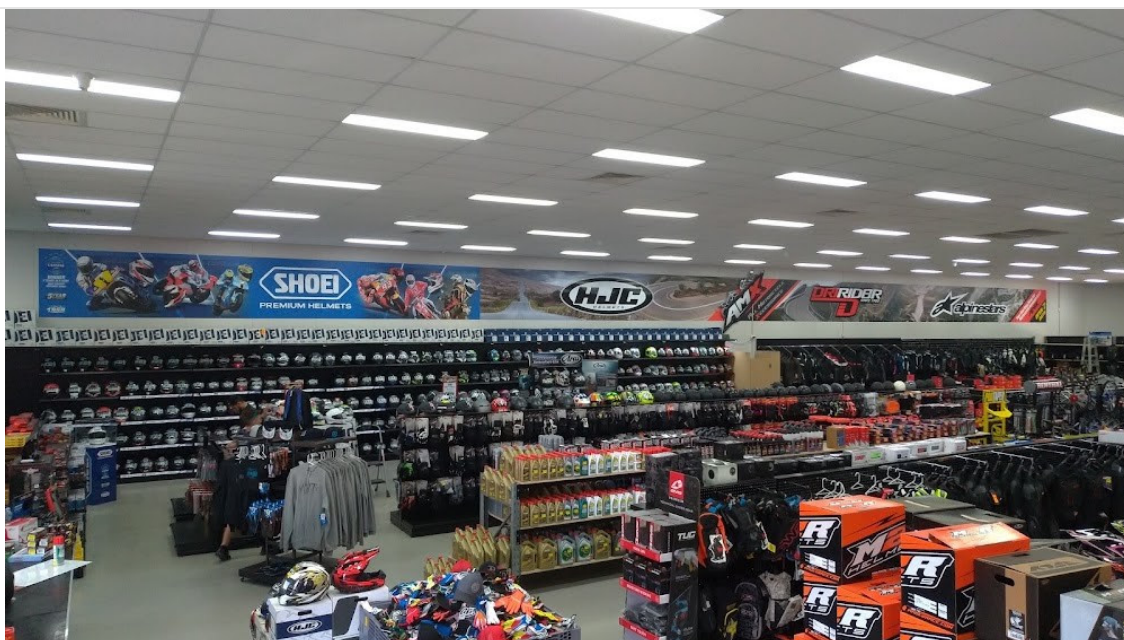
